Option 3 – Delhi – Agra – Jaipur – Delhi (04 Days / 02 Nights)

Day 1 – Delhi Sightseeing

Upon arrival, meet our representative and begin your guided tour of Delhi, a city that beautifully blends ancient heritage with modern India. Your sightseeing begins with a visit to the magnificent **Red Fort**, one of the finest examples of Mughal architecture and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Continue with a drive past the iconic **India Gate** before stopping at **Raj Ghat**, the memorial dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi.

Proceed to **Birla Mandir (Laxmi Narayan Temple)**, one of Delhi's most prominent Hindu temples, known for its impressive architecture and peaceful surroundings. After lunch at a local restaurant, visit the UNESCO World Heritage Site of **Qutub Minar**, followed by the striking **Lotus Temple**, renowned worldwide for its unique lotus-inspired architecture. Conclude your sightseeing with a visit to the magnificent **Humayun's Tomb**, another UNESCO World Heritage Site and an architectural masterpiece that inspired the design of the Taj Mahal.

After completing the tour, check in to your hotel for an overnight stay in Delhi.

Day 2 – Delhi – Agra

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive to Agra via the **Yamuna Expressway**. Upon arrival, visit the world-famous **Taj Mahal**, the timeless symbol of love built by Emperor Shah Jahan. Admire its stunning white marble architecture and discover the fascinating history behind one of the Seven Wonders of the World.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before continuing to the majestic **Agra Fort**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that once served as the residence of the Mughal emperors. Explore its magnificent palaces, audience halls, and courtyards before checking in to your hotel.

Overnight stay in Agra.

Day 3 – Agra – Fatehpur Sikri – Jaipur

Following breakfast, check out from the hotel and depart for Jaipur. En route, visit the historic city of **Fatehpur Sikri**, the former Mughal capital built by Emperor Akbar and now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore its grand palaces, impressive gateways, and beautiful courtyards before continuing your journey.

After lunch at a local restaurant, proceed to Jaipur. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel. The evening is free to relax or explore Jaipur's vibrant local markets, famous for handicrafts, textiles, gemstones, and traditional Rajasthani souvenirs.

Overnight stay in Jaipur.

Day 4 – Jaipur – Delhi

After breakfast, begin your guided tour of Jaipur, popularly known as the **Pink City**. Visit the majestic **Amber Fort**, perched atop a hill overlooking Maota Lake, and admire its splendid Rajput architecture. Continue with a photo stop at the iconic **Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds)** before visiting the magnificent **City Palace**, the residence of Jaipur's royal family.

Later, explore the UNESCO World Heritage Site of **Jantar Mantar**, one of the world's largest astronomical observatories. After lunch, begin your drive back to Delhi.

Upon arrival in Delhi in the evening, you will be transferred to your hotel or the airport, concluding your memorable Golden Triangle journey through Delhi, Agra, and Jaipur.
